- We'll provide you with **expert training** in how to engage and motivate your students, and tutor with impact - allowing you to develop transferable skills to launch your career.

CORE REQUIREMENTS:

- Eligibility to work in the UK
- Minimum C grade in GCSE English and maths (or equivalent)
- Minimum A-level/equivalent qualification at grade B or above in subject relevant to the subject you choose to tutor (English or maths)
- Minimum 2.1 degree or above in any subject (2.2 degrees will be considered if you have a strong academic record in A-level English or maths)



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FURTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Able to commit to three days of training in September 2020 (delivered remotely)
- Able to commit to delivering a minimum of 2 hours tuition a week
- Commitment to tutoring for a minimum of 12 weeks
- Ability to travel to your placement college (once face-to-face tuition resumes in the future)
- If successful, you'll need an up-to-date DBS Check

PERSONAL SPECIFICATION:

We're looking for individuals who believe in our mission, demonstrating not only a passion for tackling educational inequality, but the skills to translate this passion into action.

- You'll be able to demonstrate a personal interest in education, accompanied by the drive and commitment to make a difference.
- We're looking for communicators. You'll be able to clearly demonstrate that you are both attentive and adaptable and can convey information in a clear and engaging manner.
- You'll be able to demonstrate that you are resilient and professional – and that you will take the role seriously and consistently do your best by the students.
- You'll be able to demonstrate a clear level of insight and understanding into the challenges facing students today.
- We're looking for team players. You'll be able to demonstrate an aptitude for building and managing relationships with your students and staff at the college.
